

Learning outcome	 SWBAT define nouns by picking out naming words from a short story. SWBAT complete a story by adding nouns of your own.
Materials Required	Lesson No.: U2_GL1; Lesson Deck: □ U2_GDK1; Worksheet: ■ U2_GWS1; Answer key: ■ Answer Key of U2_GWS1.
NOTE	This deck relies greatly on student interaction. Kindly provide ample opportunity for students to voice their views. Slides are animated, kindly rehearse before the class.
Slide 3	Start the class with a breathing exercise. Move to the Next Slide.
Slide 4-9	Note: Read and explain the story. Move to the Next Slide.
Slide 10	 SAY: Read the riddle given. Note: Wait for children to respond. ASK: Does anyone know? Note: If anyone guesses the answer as 'a name', give them a big round of applause. Else SAY: Ok. The clue is in the story which we are going to read. Move to the Next Slide.
Slide 11 (Animation)	Note: Click on the slide. Read out the answer to the riddle as 'NAME'. ASK: Now what will fill the blanks? Note: Read each sentence and click for the answer to appear. Make the children repeat the



	sentence. Move to the Next Slide.
Slide 12	Note: Read the question on the slide and some of the callouts.
Slide 13	SAY: All Names are Nouns. Note: Read out the example in each category and help children to list a few nouns according to the category.
Slide 14	Note: Do the 'connect the dots' activity with the children.
Slide 15 (animation)	Note: Read and encourage children to participate with you. Move to the Next Slide.
Slide 16	Note: Read the definition noun, proper noun with example and explanation. Then read the definition of a common noun with examples and explanations.
Slide 17-22	Note: Help the children work through the exercises.
Homework	Explain Ex. 4 - Fill in the boxes with the Nouns I know. (NOTE: Teacher will explain to students how to complete the exercise)
