His, Hers and Theirs



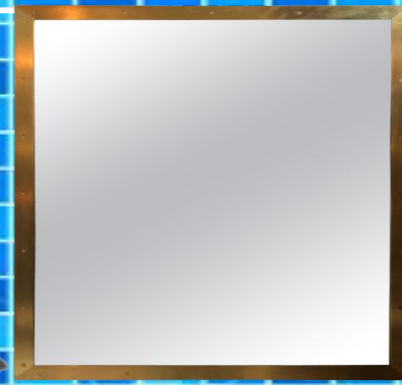
It was a lovely morning. The sun was bright, and the sky was blue. Mother woke up Vidya and Alok, as it was already late.
