



Learning outcome	SWBAT use conjunctions to connect sentences.
Materials required	Lesson deck: <a href="#">U3_GDK3</a> ; Worksheet: <a href="#">U3_GWS3</a>
Slide 3 (Animation)	SAY: Let's start with some relaxing breathing exercises. Follow my instructions carefully. SAY: Now that we are all feeling refreshed let's see what Alok has to say today!
Slide 4 (Animation)	(Alok appears on the screen) <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar</b> SAY: Alok says "Magic Potli and the Letters would like to tell you a short story. Shall we read it one by one?" <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar</b> <b>NOTE: Read out the title of the story.</b> <b>Move to the next slide.</b>
Slide 5 (Animation)	ASK: What do you think this story is about? ESR: It is about Vidya's Birthday Gift!  <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar</b> Magic Potli appears. <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: All the Letters in the Magic Potli get together for a meeting. ASK: Would you like to read the next sentence? SAY: We can each take a turn to read a sentence. <b>NOTE: Encourage the students to take turns in reading. Help them out when they are stuck at a word or have difficulty reading the sentence.</b>



	<p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR reads: They are discussing what to give Vidya, because it is her birthday next week.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR reads: They had thought of many ideas, but could not agree on one gift.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR reads: Letter M wanted to get her a doll, but Letter N was not happy with the idea.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR reads: “Vidya likes dolls, but she prefers to play gulli-danda with Alok,” N said. <b>Move to the next slide.</b></p>
Slide 6 (Animation)	<p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or space Bar.</b> ESR reads: Letter S insisted that Vidya loved to read, so she would be happy to receive some more.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR reads: Letter Q replied that because Vidya has so many books, they should get her something else.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR reads: “We can get her some ladoos or pedas” was another suggestion.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR reads: It would have gone on, but Letter Y came up with the idea of getting her flowers. <b>Move to the next slide.</b></p>
Slide 7 Slide 8 Slide 9	<p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR reads: Letter D said, “Let’s get her roses and carnations.”</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b></p>



<p>Slide 10 (Animation)</p>	<p>ESR reads: “Let’s order lilies or orchids”, said Letter K.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR reads: They wanted to get Vidya the flowers she liked, so Letters O and P came out of the Magic Potli to ask Alok for suggestions. <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR reads: Alok told them that Vidya loved orchids and roses.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR reads: The Letters were happy and called the florist, so that they could order the orchids and roses.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> <b>Move to the next slide.</b></p>
<p>Slide 11 (Animation)</p>	<p>ASK: Did you enjoy the story? ESR: Yes! SAY: I love roses very much. Which flowers do you like? ESR: Answers may vary. <b>NOTE: Some names may be in the mother tongue. Where possible, tell them the names of the flowers in English.</b></p> <p>(Vidya Appears)</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY:Vidya says “I loved the roses and orchids that I got on my birthday! Let us look at some words from the story...” SAY: Each one of you can take a turn to call out the word.</p>

Slide 12 (Animation)	<p>(Alok appears)</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Let us see how those words are used in sentences... SAY: Again, I would like each one of you to try and read the sentences. Pay close attention to the words that are marked in yellow.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR: He did well in his exams, because he had studied hard. SAY: Here the word marked is <b>because</b></p>



**NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.**

ESR: We should hold our hands and walk.

SAY: Here the word marked is **and**.

**NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.**

ESR: Alok went to bed, because it was late.

SAY: Here the word marked is **because**.

**NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.**

ESR: She goes home by bus or on her bicycle.

SAY: Here the word marked is **on**.

**NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.**

ESR: It wasn't feeling well, so he went to the doctor.

SAY: Here the word marked is **so**.

**NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.**

ESR: Seema and Neeta went to have bhel-puri.

SAY: Here the word marked is **and**.

**NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.**

ESR: It was very dark, so Alok used a torch.

SAY: Here the word marked is **so**.

**NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.**

ESR: I got late, but the teacher was not angry.

SAY: Here the word marked is **but**.

**NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.**



	<p>ESR: Do you like a rose or a marigold? SAY: Here the word marked is <b>or</b>.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR:I like roses, but I also like lilies. SAY: Here the word marked is <b>but</b>.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> <b>Move to the next slide.</b></p>
Slide 13 (Animation)	<p>(Vidya and Alok appear) <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Vidya asks Alok “Alok, do you know what these words have done?”</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Alok replies “I think that they join parts of a sentence. Am I right Vidya?”</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> <b>Move to the next slide.</b></p>
Slide 14 (Animation)	<p>(Vidya and Alok appear) <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Vidya says “Absolutely right Alok! These are words that connect or like you said ‘join’ parts of a sentence.”</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Alok replies “Thank you Vidya! Do these words have a name?”</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b></p>



	<p><b>Move to the next slide.</b></p>
Slide 15 (Animation)	<p>(Vidya and Alok appear) <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Vidya says “Yes Alok, They are called Conjunctions!”</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Alok replies “Thank you Vidya! Let us see how to use <b>and, so, because, or, but</b> in sentences”</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> <b>Move to the next slide.</b></p>
Slide 17 (Animation)	<p>(Alok appears) <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Alok says “Let us see how the Conjunctions are used to join the sentences or phrases...” ASK: Do you remember the words that were marked in yellow? ESR: Yes! ASK: What were they? ESR: and, so, because, or, but. SAY: Excellent! SAY: Once again, we can each take a turn to read the sentences.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR: We should hold our hands and walk. <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: <b>And</b> is used to join sentences or words with similar ideas.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR: Alok went to bed, because it was late.</p>



	<p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: <b>Because</b> is used to show reason.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR: He wasn't feeling well, so he went to the doctor. <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: <b>So</b> is used to show result.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR: I got late, but the teacher was not angry. <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: <b>But</b> is used to join two ideas that are opposite.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> ESR: She goes home by bus or on her bicycle. <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: <b>Or</b> is used to show a choice.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> <b>Move to the next slide.</b></p>
Slide 18 (Animation)	<p>(Vidya, Alok and Magic Potli appear) <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Vidya says "Let us take a break and have some fun!"</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Alok says "Right Vidya. Let us stand up, clap our hands and touch our toes." ASK: Are you all ready to do as Alok says?</p>





	<p>ESR: Yes! SAY: Let us stand up, clap our hands and touch our toes.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Magic Potli says “Great! Let us repeat this three more times!” SAY: So let’s go! SAY: Stand up, clap our hands and touch our toes. SAY: One more time. Stand up, clap our hands and touch our toes. SAY: One last time. Stand up, clap our hands and touch our toes.</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> <b>Move to the next slide.</b></p>
Slide 19 (Animation)	<p>(Vidya and Alok appear) <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Vidya says “Are you feeling refreshed? Let us do a small exercise to see what we have learnt.”</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: Alok says “Most certainly Vidya. I know how to identify and use conjunctions now.” ASK: Are you all ready to do the exercise? ESR: Yes!</p> <p><b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> <b>Move to the next slide.</b></p>
Slide 20 (Animation)	<p>SAY: Let us fill in the blanks <b>NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.</b> SAY: The Letters are discussing what to give Vidya, _____ it is her birthday next week.. SAY: Your options are (so, because)</p>
