

Learning outcome	SWBAT use conjunctions to connect sentences.
Materials required	Lesson deck: U3_GDK3; Worksheet: U3_GWS3
Slide 3 (Animation)	SAY: Let's start with some relaxing breathing exercises. Follow my instructions carefully. SAY: Now that we are all feeling refreshed let's see what Alok has to say today!
Slide 4 (Animation)	(Alok appears on the screen) NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar SAY: Alok says "Magic Potli and the Letters would like to tell you a short story. Shall we read it one by one? NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar NOTE: Read out the title of the story. Move to the next slide.
Slide 5 (Animation)	ASK: What do you think this story is about? ESR: It is about Vidya's Birthday Gift! NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar Magic Potli appears. NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar. SAY: All the Letters in the Magic Potli get together for a meeting. ASK: Would you like to read the next sentence? SAY: We can each take a turn to read a sentence. NOTE: Encourage the students to take turns in reading. Help them out when they are stuck at a word or have difficulty reading the sentence.



	NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar. ESR reads: They are discussing what to give Vidya, because it is her birthday next week.
	NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar. ESR reads: They had thought of many ideas, but could not agree on one gift.
	NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar. ESR reads: Letter M wanted to get her a doll, but Letter N was not happy with the idea.
	NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar. ESR reads: "Vidya likes dolls, but she prefers to play gulli-danda with Alok," N said. Move to the next slide.
Slide 6 (Animation)	NOTE: Click Enter or space Bar. ESR reads: Letter S insisted that Vidya loved to read, so she would be happy to receive some more. NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar. ESR reads: Letter Q replied that because Vidya has so many books, they should get her something else.
	NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar. ESR reads: "We can get her some ladoos or pedas" was another suggestion.
	NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar. ESR reads: It would have gone on, but Letter Y came up with the idea of getting her flowers. Move to the next slide.


Slide 10 (Animation)	ESR reads: "Let's order lilies or orchids", said Letter K. NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar.
	ESR reads: They wanted to get Vidya the flowers she liked, so Letters O and P came out of the Magic Potli to ask Alok for suggestions. NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar. ESR reads: Alok told them that Vidya loved orchids and roses.
	NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar. ESR reads: The Letters were happy and called the florist, so that they could order the orchids and roses.
	NOTE: Click Enter or Space Bar. Move to the next slide.
Slide 11 (Animation)	ASK: Did you enjoy the story? ESR: Yes! SAY: I love roses very much. Which flowers do you like? ESR: Answers may vary. NOTE: Some names may be in the mother tongue. Where possible, tell them the names of the flowers in English.




