Vidya saw her teacher, who helps teach her something new every day. Alok pointed to a sanitation worker, who is a big help in keeping the city clean.

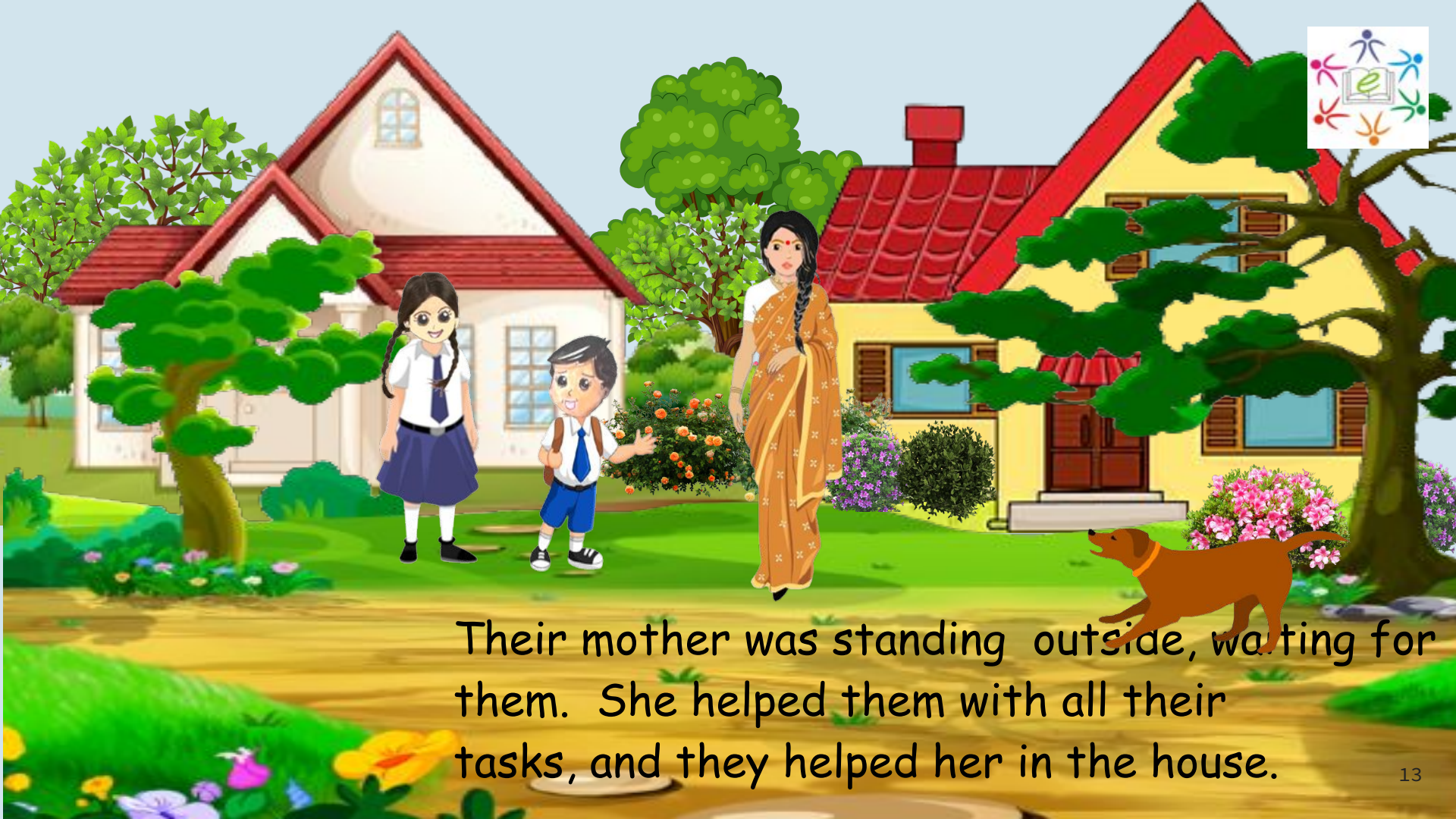


Good job, Alok! Let us walk home fast, before Amma comes searching for us.
