Breathing Exercise	<ul> <li>SAY: Let's begin today's class with the breathing exercise</li> <li>1. Close your eyes.</li> <li>2. Fold your hands.</li> <li>3. At the count of 1, breathe in.</li> <li>4. At the count of 2, breathe out ( repeat this 5 times).</li> </ul>	ESR: Yes ( to follow the instructions)
Rules for the class	SAY: ( say this in the regional language and in english)Let us set these rules for our class. SAY: Rule no 1- Listen attentively SAY: Rule no 2- Repeat when the teacher asks you to repeat	ESR: Yes Answers may vary



Recap and Hook	ASK: What did we learn in the previous class? SAY: Let's say the words and their first letter. (Refer to worksheet, exercise 1) SAY: Today we are going to read the lesson again but before that we will read some words and identify their first letters. ASK: Can you circle the first letter of the word as we say it out loud?	ESR: Answers may vary ESR: Yes, I can.
New words	Words: 1.noise 2.introduce 3.unique NOTE: Explain these words in the regional language. Have children repeat these words at least thrice. (Refer to exercise 2). Two Words of the day: <b>introduce, unique</b>	
Choral reading	<ul> <li>SAY: Now, let's read the lesson. Place your pointer finger on the first word in the textbook and move it accordingly. Now I will read, you will repeat after me.</li> <li>NOTE: Say the above in regional language as well as in english.</li> <li>NOTE: Refer to exercise 3.1. Read the paragraph. Have students repeat the same paragraph at least twice . Then have them answer the questions.</li> <li>(After EX 3.1)</li> <li>ACTIVITY: ask the children to introduce themselves to their partners by saying their name.</li> <li>NOTE: Refer to exercise 3.2. Read the paragraph. Have students repeat the same paragraph at least</li> </ul>	ESR: Answers may vary "Hello my name is"





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	twice . Then have them answer the questions. (After EX 3.2) ACTIVITY: Have children clap their hands and say "C for clap, clap, clap."
	NOTE: Refer to exercise 3.3. Read the paragraph. Have students repeat the same paragraph at least twice . Then have them answer the questions. (After EX 3.3) ACTIVITY: make the children stand and jump in their place after saying, "J for jump, jump, jump."
	NOTE: Refer to exercise 3.4. Read the paragraph. Have students repeat the same paragraph at least twice . Then have them answer the questions. (After EX 3.4) ACTIVITY: make the children say and "let's play zip zap zoom, zoom, zoom, zoom."
	NOTE: Refer to exercise 3.5. Read the paragraph. Have students repeat the same paragraph at least twice . Then have them answer the questions. (After EX 3.5) ACTIVITY: Ask the children to clap their hands 3 times and say "I am unique in my own way." Repeat this 3 times.
