Breathing Exercise	SAY: Let's begin today's class with the breathing exercise  1. Close your eyes 2. Fold your hands 3. At the count of one breathe in 4. At the count of 2 breathe out (repeat this 5 times)	ESR: Yes (to follow the instructions)	
Rules for the class	SAY: (Say this in the regional language and in English) Let us set these rules for our class. SAY: Rule no.1 - Listen attentively. SAY: Rule no.2 - Repeat when the teacher asks you to repeat.	ESR: Yes Answers may vary	



Recap and Hook	ASK: What did we learn in the previous class? SAY: Let's play a game. I will show you a letter or a sound from the lesson and then ask you a question. I need everyone to participate by raising your hands. No peeking allowed.	ESR: Answers may vary ESR: Answers may vary
	NOTE: Show them the flashcard S ASK: What sound does this letter make? NOTE: Show them the flashcard of Apple with the word written. ASK: What is the first letter of the word? ASK: What sound does the letter A make? NOTE: Show them the flashcard T ASK: What sound does this letter make? ASK: What word in the lesson starting with T gives water? NOTE: Show them the flashcard P ASK: What sound does this letter make? ASK: What word starting with P is a bird in the lesson? NOTE: Show them the flashcard I ASK: What sound does this letter make? ASK: What word in the lesson starting with the letter I is also the name of our country? NOTE: Show them the flashcard N ASK: What sound does this letter make? SAY: Today we are going to read the lesson again but before that, we will learn the meanings of new words

	NOTE: Explain these words in the regional language. Have children repeat these words at least thrice. Refer to Ex.1. Have children match the words to the pictures. Two Words of the day: Sound, blend	
Choral reading	SAY: Now, let's read the lesson. Place your pointer finger on the first word in the textbook and move it accordingly. Now I will read, you will repeat after me.  NOTE: Say the above in regional language as well as in English. Make sure to modulate your voice to make it more dramatically interesting for the students.  NOTE: Refer to Ex.2.1. Read the paragraph. Have students repeat the same paragraph at least twice. Then have them answer the questions.  (After Ex.2.1)  ACTIVITY: Share with the children two statements from the lesson. If the answer is right they will do thumbs up, if it is wrong they will do a thumbs down.  SAY: Alok and Vidya are watching the magic show on the beach.  SAY: Vidya and Alok study together.  NOTE: Refer to Ex.2.2 Read the paragraph. Have students repeat the same paragraph at least twice. Then have them answer the questions.  (After Ex.2.2)  ACTIVITY: Have children stand up, put their hands on	ESR: Answers may vary



	the waist, turn their upper body left, then right, touch your feet, come back up and say hahaha. NOTE: Refer to Ex.2.3. Read the paragraph. Have students repeat the same paragraph at least twice.
