Component of LP	Teacher Action	Student Action	
Breathing Exercise	SAY: Let's begin today's class with the breathing exercise 1. Close your eyes 2. Fold your hands 3. At the count of one breathe in 4. At the count of 2 breathe out (repeat this 5 times)	ESR: Yes (to follow the instructions)	
Rules for the class	SAY: (say this in the regional language and in english)Let us set these rules for our class. SAY: Rule no 1- Listen attentively SAY: Rule no 2- Repeat when the teacher asks you to repeat	ESR: Yes Answers may vary	
Recap and	ASK: What did we learn in the previous class?	ESR: Answers may vary	



Hook	SAY: Let's play the Animal sound game. NOTE: Call out names of animals and children can say the starting letter and also make the sound.	ESR: Students will attempt to guess the starting letter and also make the animal sound.
	SAY: Mouse SAY: Dog SAY: Goat SAY: Pig SAY: Cat	
	NOTE: Say the animal in the regional language if they are not able to identify the animal.	
	SAY: Today we are going to read the lesson again but before that we will learn the meanings of new words	
New words	Words: 1.Thunder 2.Rain 3.Octopus 4. Paper Boat 5. Expression NOTE: Explain these words in the regional language. Have children repeat these words at least thrice.	ESR : Students attempt the task
	(Refer to worksheet Exercise 1) Two Words of the day: Sound, Animal	
Choral reading	SAY: Now, let's read the lesson. Place your pointer finger on the first word in the textbook and move it accordingly. Now I will read, you will repeat after me.	



	NOTE: Say the above in regional language as well as in english. Make the student say the starting letter loudly. And also make them do the animal sounds when each animal name is taken while the lesson is read.	ESR: When the animal is called out, students make the action of the animal and also the sound.
	(Refer to worksheet Exercise 2.1,2.2,2.3,2.4) The questions are based on the new words and the two words of the day.	
	ACTIVITY: Make all children stand up. NOTE: Call out 'Monkey; ASK: What sound does it make? How does it move? NOTE: Call out 'Dog' ASK: What sound does it make? How does it move? NOTE: Call out 'Goat' ASK: What sound does it make? How does it move? NOTE: Call out 'Cat' ASK: What sound does it make? How does it move?	They perform the action as asked by the teacher.
	Note: After the activity all children clap and then sit down.	
Homework	Explain the HW activity to the students.
