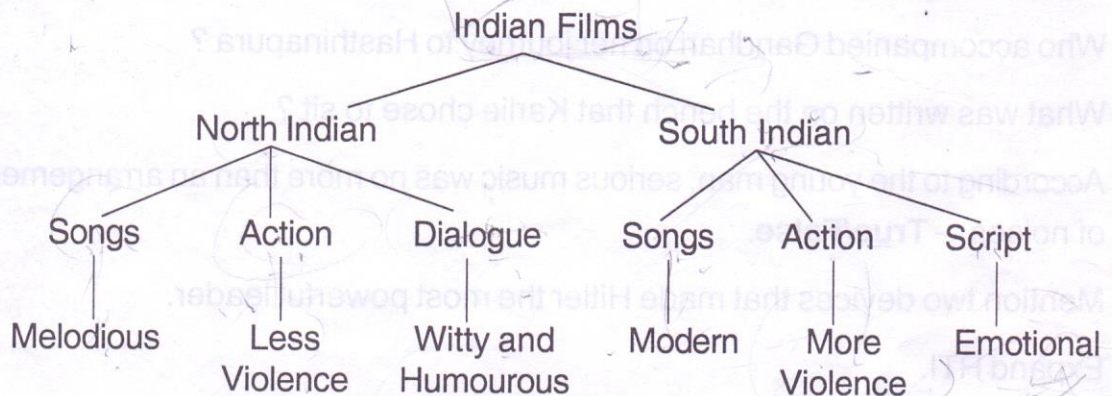
IV. Write a report on the failure of monsoon and its impact on farmers, in about **250 words** :
