An enriching briefing session on school Safety and Security was held on 23rd Feb, 2018. The speaker, Col. Deepak Raina, Administration Officer gave a detailed appraisal to the teaching and non-teaching staff regarding security measures presently in vogue as well as planned for immediate future. He reiterated the urgent need to brace the security arrangements for students and the staff particularly in view of a spate of unfortunate incidents and mishappenings in famous schools in the country. He advised the staff to be vigilant especially during dispersal / lunch/ morning hours etc. as well as during commuting by school Bus. He also requested the staff to immediately inform in case of any breach in security set up as noticed by them. He specifically mentioned that security being a dynamic process has to evolve and innovate at periodic intervals of time. He listed out the following additions being planned for future.

- Addition of about 60 cameras in the school premises, manned by constant surveillance through monitors in the server room.
- Surveillance cameras in Buses.
- Smoke detectors in wash rooms.
- HHMD (Hand-Held Metal Detector).
- Disaster management drill and evacuation plan.
- Window grills.

The staff was also trained on the use of fire- extinguishers. The meeting finally culminated with stress 'on the urgent need to be cautious and vigilant'.`
