KEY POINTS OF THE SEMINAR ATTENDED

1. Students should have expertise in all the four skills- Listening, Verbal Communication, Interpretation and Inscription skills. This would help them to acquire good communication skills and to excel in the same.
2. Active involvement of students in the class is necessary to make the lesson an interesting one.
3. There should be more focus on nurturing insights, develop critical thinking skills and to stimulate independent learning.
4. Engaging a child in the lesson by asking open and closed questions.
