

INTERNATIONAL OZONE DAY



On 16 September, 2016, International Ozone Day, students of Class XII participated in a power point presentation competition on 'Ozone and its Impact,' organized by Department of Environment, NCT- Delhi, at Delhi Secretariat. Sixteen schools participated in the event and cash prizes and certificates were awarded to the winners along with four consolation prizes. The team from our school, represented by Ms Tamanna Mishra and Ms Angelina Rao, stood third in the competition and were awarded a certificate and a cash prize of Rs 3000/- by the Secretary (Environment), Mr S.
