Activity 1: Rangoli/Mandala Art

Draw a line of symmetry on each shape.

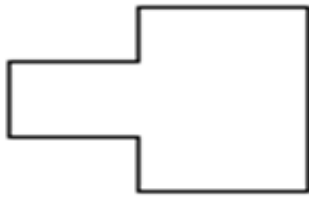

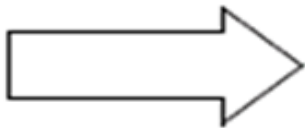
