Dear Children!

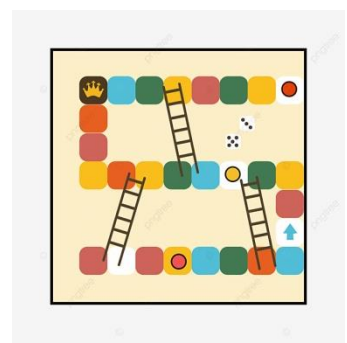

- iii. With the help of speech bubbles and illustrations, create the comic strip with a short amusing story carrying a message.

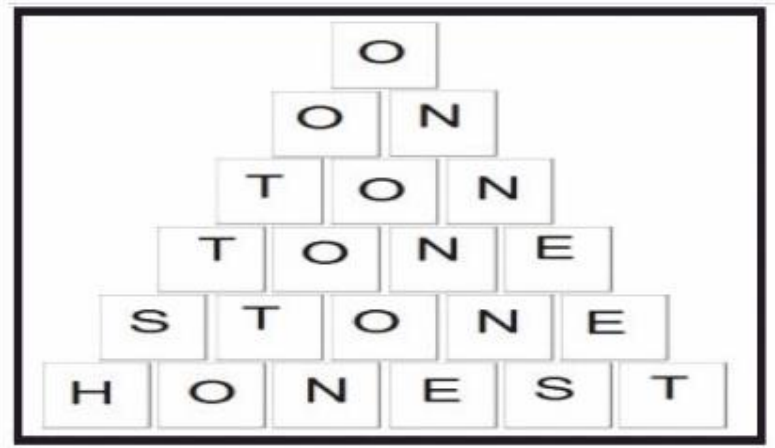
Example of a comic strip:

Method:

- i. Select a letter and write it down at the top (center) of a sheet.
For eg. O
- ii. In the line below O, write the same letter and add one other letter to it to form a 2 letter word (ON)
- iii. Keep adding one letter at each step to create a word pyramid as shown.



- iv. The letters can be rearranged (eg. HONEST). However, only 1 letter can be added in each round.
- v. Try to make as many words as possible.
