

Report:

Vemana popularly known as Yogi Vemana, was an Indian philosopher and a poet in Telugu literature. His poems are known for the use of simple language and native idioms. Many lines of Yogi Vemana's poems are now colloquial phrases of the Telugu language. They end with the signature line "Viswadaabhi raama Vinura Vema", literally Beloved of Viswada, listen to Vema. There are many interpretations of what the last line signifies. Vemana's poems were collected and published byDr. C.P. Brown in the 19th century. His poems are of many kindssocial, moral, satirical and mystic nature. Most of them are in Ataveladi. The Department of Telugu organized a Programme on "Vemana Sathaka Padya Vaibhavam" to the students of Ist and IInd Degree. The Alumni attended the programme and recited some poems from vemana Satakam To make the students well aware of sathaka padyalu, a Poem Recitation Competition was conducted on Vemana Padyalu and the winners were awarded. Dr.T. Vijaya Lakshmi, Director, Dr. S. Kalpana, Principal, Dr. A. Naga Jyothi, HOD Dept of Telugu and other members of the Department graced the occasion.
