Topic: Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Role in India as a Champion of Weaker Sections

Report:

On this day, our final and second year students expressed their views with their juniors and sub juniors on the term "Dalit" which refers to persons previously called "untouchables". They clearly described about the most well-known Dalit leader was Dr. B. R. Ambedkar (1891-1956), who represented the community during the colonial era and later acted as the chief architect of the Indian Constitution. He was a brilliant legal scholar, an astute politician, and a vociferous critic of the Indian caste system. Over the course of his political life, he waged a social and political war against untouchability. Today, most Dalit movements cast themselves as heirs to Ambedkar, but his legacy has been interpreted and carried forward in different ways. Starting in the 1960s, and particularly in the 1970s, the character of Dalit politics began to change.

Prime Minister Indira Gandhi declared a State of Emergency (1975-77) that suspended democratic rule and suppressed internal dissidents. The movement

was driven underground, but it resurfaced in the late-1970s and founded local chapters across the country. While their plan to knit them together into a pan-Indian movement never bore fruit, they created local branches in many states that became influential Dalit organizations.

Our B.A students participated actively in the SIP programme. About 55 students joined in the interactive session on "Dr.B.R.Ambedkar Role in India as a Champion of Weaker Sections" organized by the Head of the Departments of Political Science-G.Padmaja and Economics-D.Aruna respectively graced the occasion.
