Ms. D. NIKHILA DEVI, Department of Computer Science

Topic: Neural Networks in Machine Learning

Ms. Nikhila explained about Neural networks which are a core component of machine learning, designed to simulate the way the human brain processes information. Composed of layers of



interconnected nodes, or "neurons," these networks can identify patterns in data by learning from examples. She explained that Each neuron processes input data, applies weights, and passes it through an activation function to determine its significance. She stressed the importance of Neural networks which are particularly powerful for complex tasks like image recognition, language processing, and predictive analytics, where traditional algorithms struggle. She concluded that as they receive more data, these networks continuously adjust, improving their accuracy and making them indispensable for advancing AI applications.

21-11-2024

Ms. NAGA SUNEETHA, Department of Physics

Topic: Science Behind Dreams

Ms. Naga Sunitha presented that dreams occur during the rapid eye movement (REM) stage of sleep when brain activity resembles wakefulness. She explained that Scientists believe that dreams may help with memory processing, emotional regulation, and problem-solving, as the brain consolidates and



reorganizes information from the day. She also stressed that theories suggest dreams allow the brain to make sense of random neural activity, creating stories or images from stored experiences and emotions. Finally, she concluded that, though the exact purpose of dreams remains a mystery, they appear to play a role in mental health, learning, and adaptation by blending real and imagined experiences.

16.09.2024

1. Dr. M. DHANALAKSHMI, Department of Mathematics

Topic: How to write and publish a research paper.

Ms. M. Dhana Lakshmi explained the structure of the Research paper i.e. the main parts of a composition, that includes introduction, body and conclusion. She explained the significance of Title, abstract, introduction, Literature review, methodology, results, discussion, conclusion, reference, and appendices at length. Different referencing



styles, their guidelines, impact factor, reputation, editorial board, peer review process, indexing etc were also elaborated upon in her presentation.

2. Dr. G. JYOTHI, Department of Mathematics

Topic: How to publish in esteemed journals.

Ms. Jyothi gave some insights of how to publish in reputed journals. Firstly, one has to choose a journal that fits his/her research scope and follow its guidelines closely. One needs to present original, well-supported findings with clear, concise writing. She also stressed that it is important to be open to peer review feedback and be willing to revise whenever any recommendations are made. Finally, she concluded that any researcher has to ensure that the work adheres to ethical standards and contributes meaningfully to the field.



3. Ms. K. BHANUPRIYA, Department of Mathematics

Topic: How to undertake student publications?

Ms. Bhanupriya stressed on the importance of choosing an apt research topic followed by need

for conducting a thorough literature survey. This is followed by writing the draft keeping in view the guidelines and getting suitable feedback from professors, peers or mentors. She also stressed on the importance of selecting a suitable journal to publish the paper or make a presentation at a conference. Motivating and mentoring students to take up research writing was also stressed upon. She also made it clear about how to respond to the reviewer's



comments and insisted on consistency in research to bring about sustainable ideas.

23.9.2024

1. Smt. N. Saritha, Head, Dept. of Microbiology

Topic: Bloom's Taxonomy

Ms. Saritha explained about Bloom's Taxonomy as a framework for categorizing educational learning objectives. She reminded the audience of Benjamin Bloom, the creator of Bloom's taxonomy who designed it in 1956 and Lorrin Anderson who revised it in 2001. She



added that Bloom's taxonomy organizes learning outcomes into three domains: cognitive (knowledge-based), affective (emotion-based), and psychomotor (action-based). She concluded that this taxonomy helps teachers set clear, progressive goals for students, enhancing the depth and effectiveness of the learning process and demonstrated some examples of CO's, PO's, PSO's and their mapping and setting of the question paper following the above mapping.

2. Smt. A. HARIKA, Head, Dept. of Biochemistry

Topic: Course Structure

Ms. Harika explained the new course structure and the courses that was implemented in the college in view of curricular reforms formed by NEP 2020. She explained about various Skill-development courses, multidisciplinary courses, value-added courses etc are being offered by



various departments in the college. She explained the internal and external examination pattern, assessments and the marks division in detail. Further, she explained about program credits and question paper pattern in view of CO's, PO's and their mapping. This session was, in particular, targeted to create awareness in newly recruited faculty.

30.9.2024

Dr.K.N. Vara Lakshmi, Head, Dept. of Food Science & Technology

Topic: Criterion I

Ms. Varalakshmi explained how Criterion I is important in designing and updating curriculum to stay relevant to industry and societal needs. This criterion on Curricular aspects focuses on academic flexibility, innovation, and alignment with policies like the NEP. NAAC also lays importance on how effectively institutions continuously collect feedback



to refine the curriculum, ensuring students receive an education that is meaningful and future-ready. She concluded that this criterion is crucial in preparing students to meet real-world challenges and succeed in their careers.

Dr. P.V. Durgavathi, Dept. of Mathematics

Topic: Foundations of Vedic Mathematics

Ms. Durgavathi delivered an inter-active session filled with games and puzzles on ancient mathematical techniques derived from the "Atharva Veda." She explained that this system, pioneered by Swami Bharathi Krishna Tirtha Ji, simplifies calculations in arithmetic and algebra



through efficient methods like the base and complement approach. She also explained some Key methods including- finding complements (e.g., "All from 9 and the last from 10") and multiplication tricks using 9's. The presentation emphasized the advantages of Vedic Mathematics for faster, more accurate mental calculations that are useful in daily life, and for students in the examinations.

14-10-2024

Week: 9

Mrs. P. Ratna Sree, Department of English

Topic: Pronunciation

Ms. Ratna Sree explained about Phonetics, the study of sounds in human speech, focusing on how they are produced, transmitted, and received. Pronunciation using phonetics involves using symbols from the International Phonetic Alphabet (IPA) that aids in achieving accurate pronunciation by providing a consistent, universal system to map sounds



across languages. She engaged the audience by starting her presentation with a small quiz. Later she played a comic video which stressed the importance of correct pronunciation.

Dr. G. Padmaja, Head, Department of Political Science

Topic: Democracy

Ms. Padmaja explained that Democracy is a system where people have the power to make decisions about their government. She mentioned that, in a democracy, citizens vote to elect leaders and can voice their opinions on laws and policies. It is based on principles of freedom, equality, and justice, allowing everyone a fair chance to participate.



When people elect representatives, they trust them to work for the common good. Ultimately, democracy is about giving power to the people and ensuring that everyone's voice counts. She concluded the session with a small quiz that assessed her audience's attentiveness.

Mrs T. Naga Rani, Department of Commerce

Topic: Business, Commerce & Rules of Accounting

Ms. Nagarani's presentation focused on the aim of Business and Commerce that involves the exchange of goods and services. She explained that in these fields, accounting plays a critical role by establishing the financial rules and principles that govern how transactions are recorded, analysed, and reported. These rules —



such as the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) or International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) ensure accuracy, transparency, and consistency in financial statements. She stressed on the importance of proper accounting practices that help businesses assess their financial health, make informed decisions, meet regulatory requirements, and maintain credibility with stakeholders, from investors to government bodies. She ended the session with an interesting business quiz.

Ms.M. Swetha, Department of Computer Science

Topic: Different Applications Used in Teaching

Ms. Swetha, explained various on-line tools such as Semrush which is vastly useful for SEO and online visibility, while Typeset.io helps format academic papers. Quill Bot is a handy tool for paraphrasing, and Heuristica offers analytics for research. Paperpal assists in improving academic writing, and Screen



capture allows easy screen recordings. OBS (Open Broadcaster Software) and Loom both record videos for tutorials and presentations. Canva is a popular design tool, and Prezi offers dynamic presentations. Mentimeter and Slido create interactive polls and Q&As, perfect for engaging audiences. For English learning, 'Speak English with Vanessa' and 'English with Lucy' provide helpful lessons. Sivi designs visual content, OpenTalk is a conversational platform, and Discord supports real-time discussions in communities.

Kum. B. Lavanya, Department of Chemistry

Topic: Forensic Chemistry

Ms. Lavanya explained that Forensic Chemistry is the application of Chemistry to criminal investigations, focusing on analyzing evidence

from crime scenes. She added that Forensic chemists use chemical techniques to identify and quantify substances such as drugs, poisons, explosives, and trace materials and that, their analyses help determine what substances are present, how they might have been used, and link suspects to criminal activities. She presented various slides that depicted the necessity of forensic chemistry in detecting crimes.

Kum. Ch. Meghala, Department of Microbiology

Topic: Benefits of Probiotics

Ms. Meghala explained that probiotics are beneficial live bacteria and yeasts that support gut health and overall well-being. She also explained that they help balance the gut microbiome, improving digestion, enhancing immune function, and potentially reducing symptoms of digestive issues like irritable bowel syndrome (IBS). She stressed the fact



that probiotics may also aid in nutrient absorption, reduce the risk of certain infections, and contribute to mental health by influencing the gut-brain axis. She finally concluded that regular intake of probiotics, through foods like yoghurt or supplements, can support a healthy microbiome and improve quality of life.
