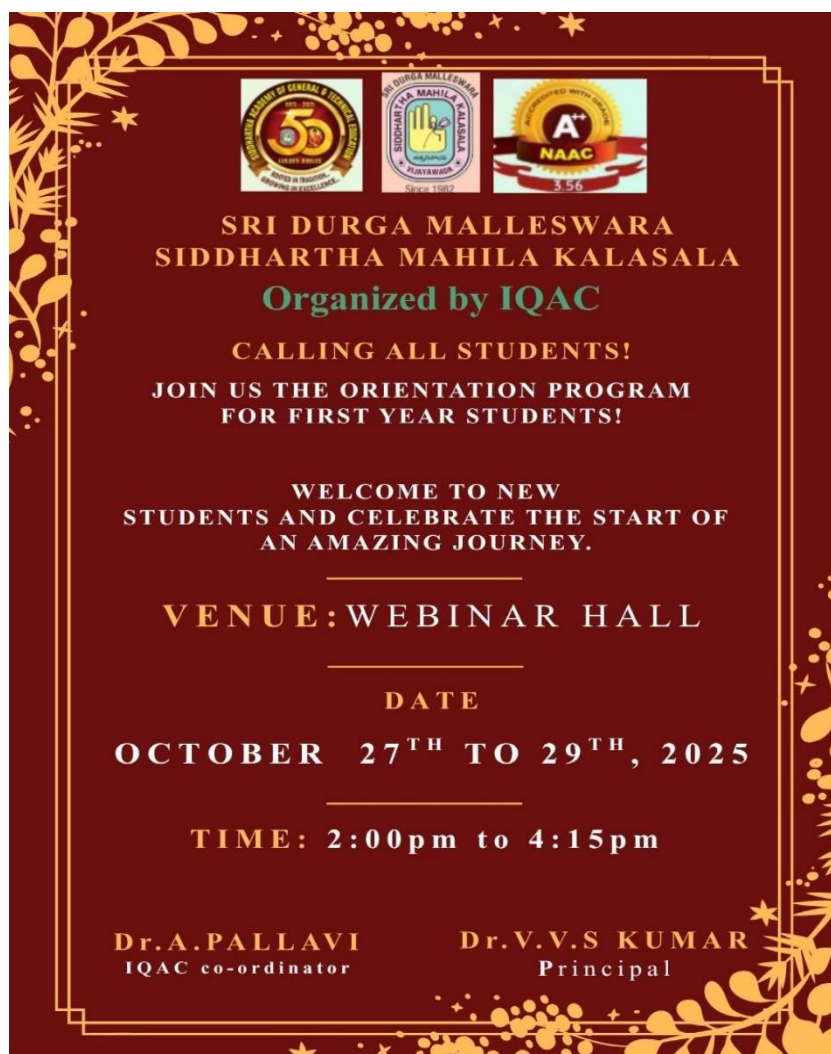

PROGRAMME HIGHLIGHTS

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Sri Durga Malleswara Siddhartha Mahila Kalasala organized an Orientation Programme for the First-Year Degree students to acquaint them with the institution's academic system, values, and opportunities. The programme aimed to guide the fresher's in adapting smoothly to the new academic environment and to provide an overview of the college's policies, infrastructure, and support mechanisms. The session commenced with a welcome address, followed by a series of informative talks delivered by the college officials and committee convenors.

ADDRESSING BY THE PRINCIPAL

The Principal addressed the gathering, providing a detailed overview of the general information and brief history of the college. 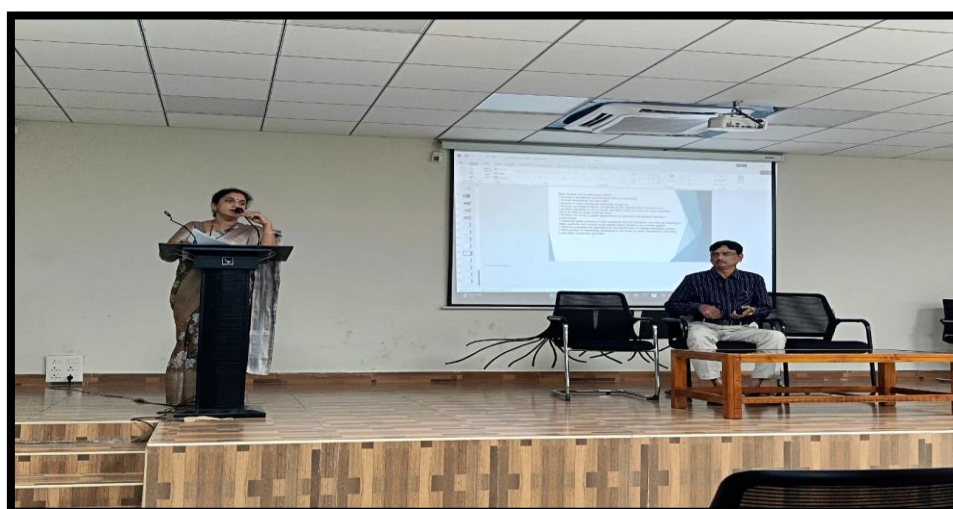
ADDRESSING BY THE ADDITIONAL CONTROLLER OF EXAMINATIONS
