" Training Program On Mushroom Cultivation "

The Department of Botany organized a two-day "Mushroom Cultivation Training Program" on 2nd March 2025. The session was led by the resource person, Sri T. Jayachand, who provided in-depth insights into the nutritional and medicinal benefits of milky mushrooms. He covered essential topics such as post-harvest packaging and management, marketing strategies, required machinery and equipment, and the proper layout of a mushroom farm. The training also addressed critical aspects like disease and pest management, sanitation, and food safety in mushroom farming. Additionally, participants were educated on the techniques for identifying edible mushrooms and distinguishing them from poisonous varieties. The program proved to be highly informative and beneficial for those interested in commercial mushroom cultivation.

Academic Study tour - Mangroove Forest, Hamsaladeevi

On March 3, 2025, students from the Department of Aquaculture and Zoology's I, II, and III B.Sc. Aquaculture and AZC programs embarked on an academic study tour to the Hamsaladeevi Mangrove Forest, located at the confluence of the Bay of Bengal and the Krishna River. This ecologically significant site, part of the Krishna Wildlife Sanctuary, is renowned for its rich biodiversity and vital role in maintaining ecological balance. The mangrove forest acts as a natural buffer against coastal erosion, provides habitat for various species, and supports both marine and terrestrial life. During the visit, students observed unique flora and fauna, including the rare Fishing Cat, vulnerable Olive Ridley Turtles, Fiddler Crabs, Mudskippers, Telescopium Snails, Black-Capped Kingfishers, and the Solomon Arab Butterfly. Dolphins were also occasionally spotted in the area.

The study tour offered students a hands-on learning experience, enhancing their understanding of the ecological importance of mangrove forests in coastal protection, biodiversity conservation, and ecosystem stability. Under the guidance of the Andhra Pradesh Forest Department, students also participated in conservation activities, such as protecting turtle eggs. The visit was a valuable opportunity to reinforce their knowledge of both aquatic and terrestrial ecosystems while highlighting the urgent need for conservation efforts to preserve these delicate environments.

The Department of English of Sri Durga Malleswara Siddhartha Mahila Kalasala organised a Two-Day International Conference on "New Frontiers in Visual Communication & Mass Media" on 6th & 7th March, 2025. The Chief Guest for the inaugural session was Prof. Usha Reddy, Rtd. Director, A.V Research Centre, Osmania University, Hyderabad. The Guest of Honour was Prof. Nargis Abraham, Faculty, BCIT University of British Columbia, Canada.

The Inaugural Session featured keynote addresses by Prof. Nargis Abraham & Prof. Usha Reddy. Prof. Nargis Abraham spoke about the importance of improving one's skills in creating a strong resume and on-line platforms like Linked In, Nakuri.com, Indeed etc. for good careers. She stated that in just 6 seconds employers from abroad and India could select a good resume from bad ones. Hence utmost care should be taken when writing resumes. Prof. Usha Reddy highlighted the importance of ethics and good values to be observed when using online platforms for various purposes. Plagiarism, Cyber bullying, and Unethical Communication should be strongly avoided by students and users of Social media.

The Valedictory Session was attended by Dr. S. Kalpana, Principal and Dr. R. Madhavi, Special Officer. The keynote speaker Dr. N. Usha, Principal and Registrar, Krishna University, Machilipatnam emphasised on digital dominance in the field of Visual Communication and Mass Media.

She expressed that English as a universal language plays a pivotal role to communicate with diverse global audiences. She cited real-life examples of how Japanese cartooning is viewed with Telugu and English subtitles. She told English speakers have good opportunities but multilingual speakers will have more opportunities.

MEDICAL CAMP

On March 11, 2025, the Wellness Club of Sri Durga Malleswara Siddhartha Mahila Kalasala, in collaboration with the Dr. Pinnamaneni Siddhartha Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Foundation, organized a four-day Medical Camp aimed at promoting student health and well-being. The camp focused on preventive healthcare and offered a variety of essential medical services, consultations, and awareness sessions for students, faculty, and staff. Key highlights of the camp included blood pressure (BP) and haemoglobin (Hb) tests to detect early signs of anaemia and hypertension, as well as general physician consultations for common health issues.



Female students were provided with valuable gynaecological consultations to address personal health concerns, while medical professionals also offered advice on healthy lifestyles, stress management, and nutrition. Throughout the camp, participants received personalized medical recommendations, and many students were identified with health concerns that required follow-up care. The camp successfully increased awareness among students about the importance of regular health monitoring, anaemia prevention, and proper nutrition. It also empowered female students with knowledge about menstrual hygiene and gynaecological health. By offering comprehensive healthcare services and advice, the camp reinforced the college's commitment to fostering a healthy campus environment and ensuring access to essential medical support.

“World Water Day: Water for Today, Security for Tomorrow”

The Department of Chemistry organized a Guest Lecture on "Monitoring of Ground Water Quality: Chemical Analysis & Interpretation in Andhra Pradesh" on March 22, 2025, in observance of World Water Day. The session, attended by 130 students from various Departments, Sri Guru Raghavendra, Deputy Director of the Ground Water Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh, provided a detailed overview of water quality parameters for both surface and groundwater in the state. He highlighted the role of five major water testing laboratories in Vijayawada, Kadapa, Kurnool,



Visakhapatnam, and Rajahmundry, which test 18 different water quality parameters to ensure



water suitability for drinking and agricultural purposes. The session covered the use of various analytical instruments, including the pH Meter, Conduct Meter, Flame Photometer, Nephlo Turbid Meter, and UV-Visible Spectrophotometer, all of which play a crucial role in assessing water safety and usability.
