Name of The Event: “Field trip to Vegetable gardens at Kannuru Vijayawada”

Brief report:

The Department of Botany organized a field trip to vegetable-yielding agricultural fields for students. The purpose of the visit was to observe different crops and understand their cultivation methods, plant characteristics, and agricultural practices.

During the trip, students visited several crop fields including **cauliflower fields cabbage fields, turmeric fields, sugarcane fields, and kakara (bitter gourd) fields**. The farmers explained the methods of planting, irrigation, pest control, and harvesting techniques used for these crops.

Students also had the opportunity to visit fields where **medicinal plants** were cultivated. They observed various medicinal species and learned about their uses in traditional medicine and their economic importance.

In addition, the students observed **field bunds (gattulu)** where many useful wild and medicinal plants were naturally growing. This helped them understand plant diversity in agricultural ecosystems.

The field trip was very informative and helped students gain practical knowledge about crop plants, medicinal plants, and farming practices. It also enhanced their understanding of plant diversity and the importance of agriculture in daily life.
