- Authors are requested to identify the track in which their paper needs to be considered. Track indication may be given in the title page of the abstract.

- The title should be no longer than 15 words.
- Word limit for extended abstract is 1,000-1,500 words, including charts, figures and tables. References are not included in the word limit. The abstract should clearly indicate the purpose of research.
- By submitting an abstract, the author makes a commitment to present his/her paper at the conference.
- Each abstract should have at least three to five keywords.
- All abstracts will be blind peer-reviewed.



- In a joint submission, at least one of the co-authors should be registered for the conference.
- All the selected extended abstracts will be published in a compendium.
- Please format the document in MSWord and in Times New Roman, font size of 12, and single spaced. Please see the template of the extended abstract for your ready reference.
