In this year feedback collected to online with the help of Google form. Feedback is vital part of teaching and learning process. Feedback from regular students has been taken at the once session of each session. Similarly teachers are also collected.


Data collection and Analysis -






The feedback from the students is collected on the subject teacher of the various subjects and analyzed four scale point. We have received total 6483 student's feedback.




Student Feedback for College Facilities

We have collected feedback from our graduate and post graduate students and under graduate students. We have received total 1277 student's feedback on college facility and analyzed four scale point.










Student's Feedback regarding Curriculum-


The students are the most important stakeholder of Higher education system. The interest of participation of students at all levels both internal quality assurance and external quality assurance have played a central role.






Depth of Syllabus (पाठ्यक्रम में गहनता)






Competitive exam oriented syllabus
